Since 2005, CLC bio and now QIAGEN has been a company with an Aarhus division that holds a high scientific level of expertise across computer science and molecular biology and genetics. CLC bio really took off when NGS became the focus, and it led to the acquisition of CLC bio by QIAGEN in 2013. Since then, the project and product development breadth of QIAGEN Aarhus has increased, and we are now developing software for genomic research across all organisms, biomarker discovery and diagnostic genetic tests.

I will briefly introduce the history of the Aarhus division, the role of the Aarhus division in QIAGEN today, the projects and products we contribute to and the profile and composition of the teams.
